# Wednesday, December 7, 2022 – TIMELINE and Leadership Duties (please and thank you )

Attire for concert: Concert Attire – marching band students will change into uniform after their respective concert band performance. Concert band only students will remain in concert attire for the final number!

# 5:45pm - All section leaders - meet in Band Room for brief meeting with instruments - in concert attire

Drum Majors at all doors (two at Panther Dome entrances and two at main entrance)

SL and Coordinators will serve as beginning band member escorts to the MPR – be at both entrances to the school.

6:00pm – Wind ensemble personnel arrive and be dressed in uniform (concert attire)

will serve as greeters for seating 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade bands in back bleachers.

Woodwind members at the main entrance and the Dome entrance to direct students where to go.

<u>Brass members</u> will be near the back bleachers to assist with seating – make sure the students do not play. Have the students keep their folding stands with them. Cases may be placed alongside the back bleachers.

Clarinets & Bass—all chairs and stands—first row—chairs stacked, stands back to band room neatly placed—trash on floor/bleachers Saxes—all chairs and stands—second & third row—chairs stacked—taken upstairs—stands back to band room neatly placed—

Trumpets & Trombones- all chairs and stands – fourth & fifth row – chairs stacked – taken upstairs – stands back to band room neatly placed, help take extra jazz equipment back,

Tubas – all chairs and stands –sixth row – chairs stacked – taken upstairs – stands back to band room neatly placed

Make sure sousaphones are neatly placed back in band room.

MB Battery – all concert percussion and stands back to band room neatly placed – report to Mr. Hinds.

Drum Majors & Coordinators - get podiums and double check that everything is completed
