Listed are a couple tips for parents/guardians to ensure no issues with approval:

- On the IL State physical Health History **must** be completed and signed by the parent/guardian.
- On the IHSA physical (sports physical) all sections must be completed, and it must be signed by **both** the student and parent/guardian.
- On both physicals it must be noted by MD that student is approved for sports (a box to be checked on each).
- If it is marked as modified the modifications must be specifically noted or it is a Not Approved in essence.
- Submit to the band physical link as it may not be addressed if sent to one of us individually as we'll
 be rotating days worked.
